Burlington County Retirees' Education Association

The Burlington County Retirees' Education Association will be awarding two local scholarships.

New Jersey Disabled American Veterans

The New Jersey Disabled American Veterans will be awarding 3 \$1,500 scholarships to graduating high school seniors for post-high school education.

The Scholarship Committee has established the following criteria for eligibility:

- Applicant must be a NJ resident
- Applicant must be a natural or adopted descendant of a member of the Disabled American Veterans, Dept. of NJ (son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter, niece, nephew, cousin).
- Applicant must be a high school senior
- Applicant must submit, in his or her own words, an essay of no more than 500 words on "My Vision of American, and What I Would Do To Improve It."
- Application and essay must be typed or print legibly in its entirety
- Applicant may submit only ONE application

- Applicant must sign and date authentication. Parent or guardian signature is also required if applicant is under 18
- Applicant must provide proof of relationship and that the veteran is a member of the Disabled American Veterans
